Accessibility Statement; Ontario, Canada

In accordance with our Group Policies on Equality, Diversity and Inclusion and Health, Safety and Wellbeing, we care about our people, and those influenced by our actions through our projects. We will treat everyone fairly, with dignity and respect; as we would wish to be treated.

Arup Canada (which refers herein to Arup Canada Inc. and AAC, Inc.) is committed to providing equal access and participation for people with disabilities. Our objective is to provide an environment of mutual respect in which all persons who access our office in Ontario and services can do so in a timely manner irrespective of any disability they may have. In particular, Arup Canada will do so by seeing that its operations in Ontario are compliant, as far as reasonably practicable, with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005.

Our employment practices take account of, as far as reasonably practicable, any accessibility requirements.

Clear accessible processes are in place for individuals to raise concerns about how the firm provides its services to persons with disabilities and for resolving any such concerns.

Governance
